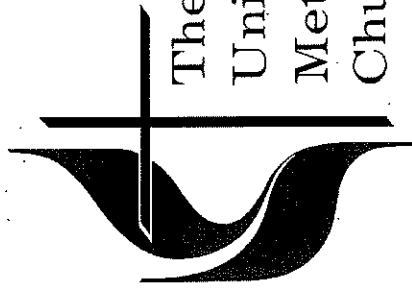




**About Wanda Dover**

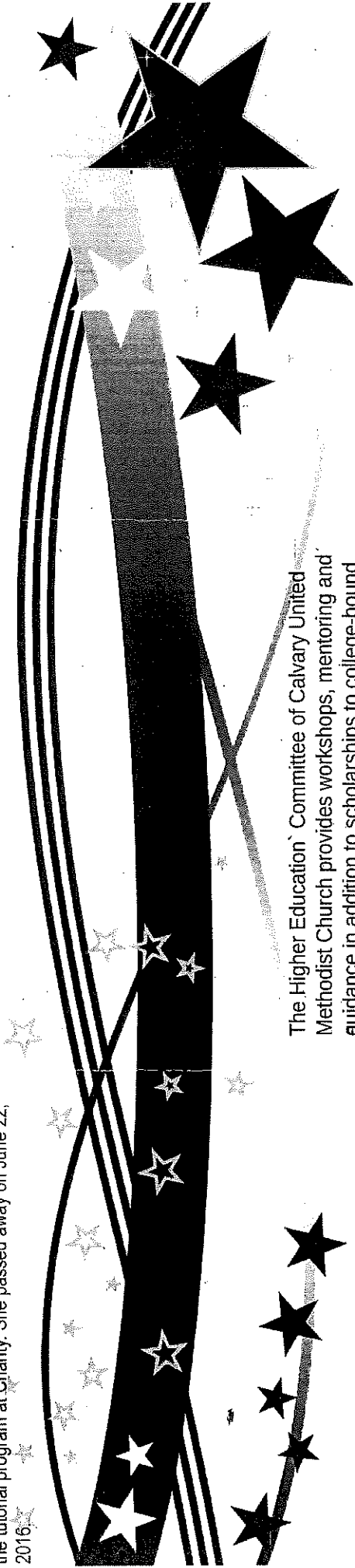

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## Scholarship Criteria

Interested students must meet the criteria below to qualify for the Wanda Dover Educational Scholarship.

### Criteria

- Be a graduating high school senior
- Have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale
- Be a citizen of the United States
- A resident of Genesee county Mich.
- Plan on attending a four-year college or university in the state of Michigan

### How to apply

Students will need to complete the following to apply for a Wanda Dover Educational Scholarship:

- **Provide the following with your application packet:**

- Official copy (with a raised seal) of your most recent high school transcript.
- One-page bio and personal statement (typed and double-spaced)
- A list of your extracurricular activities, leadership roles, community service and work history
- One letter of recommendation (no family members; can be from a pastor, counselor, teacher, work supervisor, athletic coach or other member of the community who is familiar with the background of the student)
- A copy of your college admission letter

Please follow the instructions on the scholarship application, including the application deadline and how to submit your application packet.

**Students who fail to follow the application instructions and/or submit their applications after the deadline will be disqualified**
