APRIL SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: April 30th & July 31st, 2024

1) Air Force Association Scholarships - \$10,000 – 12 Awards (Deadline: April 30, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a dependent of an Active-Duty Guard, Reserve, veteran, or retired member of any service branch.
- B) Be planning to enroll in a program of study at an accredited college or university in the Fall of 2024.

2) Nurse Corps Scholarship Program - \$10,000 - 225 Awards (Deadline: May 2, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be accepted or enrolled at an accredited school of nursing located in the United States.
- B) Plan on pursuing one of the following types of nursing programs: Diploma in Nursing, Associate Degree in Nursing, Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Nurse practitioner, or a Graduate level advanced registered nurse.

3) SEE Education Foundation Scholarships - \$5,000 - 15 Awards (Deadline: May 6, 2024)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be pursuing a technical, undergraduate, graduate, or doctorate in a field related to the commercial explosives industry.

- A) Be a graduating high school senior planning to be a full-time student in the Fall of 2024.
- B) Create a video answering the question "What has science done for me?" or "What has science done for somebody I know?".

- B) Be a legal resident of the United States.
